Qualifications

- 5+ years of natural gas operations experience.
- Knowledge of natural gas pipeline operations including pigging.
- Knowledge of natural gas facility operations including dehydration, compression, regulation, and metering.
- Knowledge of the Department of Transportation PHMSA and other pertinent regulatory standards.
- Must have knowledge of control system, i.e., SCADA, PLC, including; operating and troubleshooting, all facility and pipeline equipment and SCADA functions.
- Must have computer skills and proficiency using MS Office.
- Must be a team player with excellent communication skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively both written and orally.
- Must be self-directed and able to perform duties with little or no supervision.
- Must have a valid driver’s license and maintain a clean driving record.

Responsibilities

- Exercise characteristics common with having ownership of facilities and operations.
- Starting up, shutting down and monitoring facility equipment.
- Issuing work permits.
- Troubleshooting problems with all company assets and equipment.
- Adhering to safe working practices.
- Ensure safe, efficient and sustainable operation of assets.
- Assist in the development, tracking and delivery of facility operational efficiency targets.
- Perform administrative functions relating to operations, including reports and records.
- Ensure compliance with all relevant/required regulations/programs both internally and externally.
- Day to day liaison with internal and external customers.
- Perform housekeeping of all facilities to maintain cleanliness and general appearance to maintain a safe and healthy work environment.
- Continually gain knowledge of all aspects of operations.
- Recommend and specify proper equipment and procedural needs to meet company goals.
- Test and troubleshoot all equipment and systems to support operations.
- Complete and maintain proper records.

- Ensuring the operation of all equipment by completing preventive maintenance requirements, repairs and maintaining appropriate equipment inventories.
- Assist in the management and organization of all aspects of operations and maintenance.
- Assist construction on an as needed basis to achieve company goals.
- Assist other disciplines as needed to achieve company goals
- Perform inspection and startup functions as necessary to support construction and commissioning of new facilities.
- Assist/consult with engineering and procurement in the design of new facilities.
- Utilize all required “tools” and equipment necessary to support the functions of the job.

Physical Demands

- Auditory attention and hearing sensitivity is required, as candidates must possess the ability to distinguish various sounds the serve as key maintenance indicators.

- Standing or sitting for long periods of time may be required.

Work Environment

- Work environment typical of those in oilfield operations.
- Travel may be required for assignments, training and meetings.
- Natural gas gathering and processing is an “around the clock” operation and incumbents are required to be reasonably available to respond to emergency and other operational needs whenever they occur.
- Must be available for rotating on-call schedule, occasional unscheduled call-outs and extended workdays and/or workweeks.
- Overtime, weekends and/or holiday hours may be required.

- Experience in natural gas processing.
- Experience in natural gas transmission.
